## God the Father

- the Trinity is a separate issue for a later session
- it will be tricky to separate descriptions of 'God' from 'God the Father'

## **God is Uncreated**

- Eternal
- Everlasting
- Unchanging (?)
- Questions:
  - Who made God?
  - Where did God come from?
  - Eternity: Timelessness or Unending Time?
  - Does God know the future ('Open Theism')? Does God learn?

# God is Infinite

- Omnipresent
- Omniscient
- Omnipotent
- Questions:
  - Where is God?
  - Does God have any limits? e.g.
    - Can He create a rock so big that He cannot lift it?
    - Can He be tempted to do wrong? Can He lie?
    - Why doesn't he destroy Satan?
    - Why doesn't he end evil and suffering?

# God is Spiritual

- Questions:
  - What is Spirit?
  - What does it mean to have been created "in God's image"?
  - Does God have a body?
  - Has anyone ever seen God (and lived)?

# God is Glorious

- Questions:

- What is the "glory of God"?
- How can creation and created beings give God glory?
- How can created beings share in God's glory?
- How can we "fall short" of God's glory?
- Isn't it vain, selfish, and egocentric for God to demand our worship?
- Does God require our praise?

## **God is Creator**

- Questions:
  - How could God create something out of nothing?
  - Did God create sin? Did God create the Devil?
  - How could an all-powerful, all-loving, all-knowing God create an imperfect Universe?
  - How can an unchanging God create anything?
  - What about Evolution? Who is creating now?

## God is Loving

- God has a mind and He thinks
- He reasons
- He remembers
- He has emotions
  - He grieves
  - He can be angry
  - He shows mercy
  - He rejoices
  - He suffers
- He has choices and make decisions
- Questions:
  - Is God is loving then why do the innocent suffer?
  - If God is love, then how can He be angry?
  - If God is good, then how can He be jealous?
  - How can an all-powerful being suffer?
  - How can God "regret" decisions He has made?
  - Why does God love the world but tell us not to love it?
  - Is God masculine or feminine?

#### God is Active in History

- God changes His actions when people change
- God tests people and responds to their response
- God's future decisions appear to be future to Him
- Questions:
  - Is the past/present/future all the same to God?

## God is Holy

- Questions:
  - What does it mean to be 'holy'?
  - What does God mean when he asks us to be holy?

#### Names/Titles of God

- El/Eloah: God "mighty, strong, prominent"
  - El Elyon: "Most High"
  - EL Shaddai: "God Almighty"
  - El Roi: "God of Seeing"
  - El-Olam: "Everlasting God"
  - El-Gibhor: "Mighty God"
- Elohim: God "Creator, Mighty and Strong" (plural of El)
- Adonai: "Lord" (substitute for YHWH)
- Yahweh/Jehovah/YHWH: "LORD" (true name/Tetragrammaton)
  - Yahweh-Jireh: "The Lord will Provide"
  - Yahweh-Rapha: "The Lord Who Heals"
  - Yahweh-Nissi: "The Lord Our Banner"
  - Yahweh-M'Kaddesh: "The Lord Who Sanctifies, Makes Holy"
  - Yahweh-Shalom: "The Lord Our Peace"
  - Yahweh-Elohim: "LORD God"
  - Yahweh-Tsidkenu: "The Lord Our Righteousness"
  - Yahweh-Rohi: "The Lord Our Shepherd"
  - Yahweh-Shammah: "The Lord is There/Present"
  - Yahweh-Sabaoth/Tzevaot: "The Lord of Hosts"
  - Yah/Jah: (first letter of YHWH, used in peoples' names)
- Ehyeh-Asher-Ehyeh "I am that I am" (or other variations)
- HaShem: "The Name" (substitute for Adonai)
- Abba: "Father/Pappa/Daddy" (NT)
